<p>SPRING FLAVOR</p> <p>Sweet and refreshing with just a hint of tang. This first Plumcot of the season has bright red, lightly speckled skin and crisp, white flesh.</p>  <p>MID TO LATE MAY</p>	<p>FLAVOROSA</p> <p>Rich and satisfying flavors like cherry and pomegranate explode from the deep, red skin and flesh. Juicy and tantalizing, it's a sweet welcome to summer.</p>  <p>LATE MAY/EARLY JUNE</p>	<p>TROPICAL PLUMANA</p> <p>A delight for all of your senses. Fragrant and exotic flavors – like a fruit-filled island drink. Beautiful red and green speckled skin.</p>  <p>MID JUNE</p>	<p>EARLY DAPPLE</p> <p>Sweet, wonderfully complex flavors highlight the juicy flesh. Mottled red and green skin with luscious red flesh.</p>  <p>LATE JUNE</p>	<p>DAPPLE FIRE</p> <p>Also called “nectacotum.” Part nectarine as well as plum and apricot. It has a firmer texture and a very subtle nectarine flavor.</p>  <p>JULY TO EARLY AUG.</p>
<p>SWEET TREAT</p> <p>The first green Plumcot of the season. Delicate green skin hides a honey-sweet yellow flesh. Don't let the green skin fool you – it's sweet!</p>  <p>MID TO LATE JULY</p>	<p>DAPPLE DANDY</p> <p>Flavor that's consistently sweet and delicious. Dark red speckles on a greenish background and beautiful red to pink flesh.</p>  <p>AUGUST</p>	<p>FLAVOR QUEEN</p> <p>Very sweet and mellow flavor. Delicate green to slightly yellow skin with a creamy golden flesh. Green equals extreme sweetness in Plumcots.</p>  <p>EARLY TO MID AUG.</p>	<p>FLAVOR JEWEL</p> <p>This beautiful gem tastes as wonderful as it looks. Sweet, creamy white flesh with splashes of color radiating inward from the skin.</p>  <p>MID TO LATE AUG.</p>	<p>FLAVOR GRENADE</p> <p>A crisp, refreshing, sweet explosion of flavor. Oblong in shape with slightly bumpy skin. Green to yellow skin with patches of red and an extra juicy yellow flesh.</p>  <p>MID TO LATE AUG.</p>
<p>KING KONG</p> <p>Big fruit with a big taste. Pleasantly sweet, plum-like flavors highlighted with hints of almond. Very dark skin with a nicely contrasting cream-colored flesh.</p>  <p>LATE AUG./EARLY SEPT.</p>	<p>EMERALD BEAUT</p> <p>Technically a green plum. The flesh is succulent and bursting with flavor. This delicate variety is handled so that it keeps its natural waxy coating.</p>  <p>EARLY TO MID SEPT.</p>	<p>FLAVOR FALL</p> <p>A firm, juicy fruit with sweet, plum-like flavors and subtle hints of apple. Very large, and slightly oblong. The color ranges from red/purple to full dark purple and the skin tends to be bumpy.</p>  <p>OCTOBER</p>	<p>WHAT IS A PLUMCOT? Plumcots are an adventurous cross between a plum and an apricot, highlighting delicious components of both its plum and apricot parentage. Crosses of different varieties of plums and apricots yield a wide array of tantalizing colors and flavors. Experience the flavor adventure all summer long.</p> <p>SELECTION & STORAGE Select fruit that's firm with just a slight “give.” Store on the kitchen counter until they are soft and juicy, then refrigerate for up to a week.
