

## COST ACCOUNTANT

Position Summary: The Cost Accountant will be responsible for undertaking all aspects of cost accounting, financial reporting, budget, and job costing preparations. The incumbent will also oversee the month-end financial close of all costing and reporting processes; financial planning and analysis, budget comparisons, reconciliation of various financial data and journal entries.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Maintain and improve costing models used to create pack charges.
- Analyze historical and forecast future costs as it relates to: labor, materials, burden.
- Establish operating budgets in coordination with department heads.
- Periodically review income statement and balance sheet.
- Establish and monitor labor, material, and burden budgets.
- Monitor the operation's financial performance daily, weekly, monthly, and annual basis.
- Work with all departments on budget vs actual performance analysis.
- Review and maintain general ledger accounts to ensure proper categorizing of expenses.
- Review recording of fixed assets to ensure proper department/entity allocation of assets.
- Review depreciation schedules for accuracy.
- Verify and sign-off on all third-party vendor invoices.
- Maintain Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) Database.
- Analyze farm operations, equipment availability, utilization and life cycle cost benefits.
- Capture and report cost of goods sold and production reports.
